

Christchurch Cemetery, Jumpers Road

The first burial in Christchurch Cemetery took place on 1st January 1858. Despite its proximity to Barrack Road the cemetery remains a very peaceful and picturesque place, housing a small chapel just inside the gateway.

There is a section of the cemetery set aside for traditional graves, although this is almost full. The majority of the grounds are laid to lawn, allowing for a simple headstone on each grave. There is also a Garden of Remembrance for the interment of cremated remains.

Although not solely reserved for residents of the Borough of Christchurch, non-residents do have to pay double fees if they wish to be buried here or purchase a plot for future use.
