As the name suggests it enjoys panoramic views of the backwater of Poole Harbour, Purbeck Hills and Corfe Castle. Upton Cemetery

This small cemetery is situated just to the north of the A35 Upton by-pass, accessed a few yards from the flyover roundabout. Recently extended it has reasonable space available for some years to come. Full size graves are available in 'lawn' only, meaning the grave may be dressed by a headstone and not by kerbing. Graves for cremated remains are also available. The cemetery suffers from high watertable in some areas and consideration should be given to the viability of double depth graves; the purchase of an adjoining grave and single depth preparation being the alternative.

Upton Cemetery is reserved for the residents of Upton and Lytchett Minster. For these residents the fees are inexpensive. Non-residents may use the cemetery but are required to pay a very large additional fee often making the option unrealistic. Please click here to see the table of fees for Upton Cemetery.

The cemetery does suffer from its close proximity to the busy A350/A35 junction with considerable noise and water run-off being experienced.

The cemetery is controlled by the local PCC and restricts memorials to being of Lawn type and preferable constructed from Purbeck Stone.
